Capital Investment Plan – Procurement Thresholds

As per Canada-PEI Infrastructure Secretariat Guidelines, and the *Municipal Government Act* best practices, recipients of Gas Tax Funding are required to follow proper procurement practices.

As at August 12, 2019 – current procurement thresholds are as follows:

Goods	
Quotation Threshold (Written – two or three recommended)	
Goods	\$0 - \$999 no quotes required
Goods	\$1,000 - \$9,999 requires 2 written quotes
Goods	\$10,000 + must be publicly tendered

Services	
Quotation Threshold (Written – two or three recommended)	
Services	\$0 - \$999 no quotes required
Services	\$1,000 - \$49,999 requires 2 written quotes
Services	\$50,000 + must be publicly tendered

Construction	
Quotation Threshold (Written – two or three recommended)	
Construction	\$0 - \$999 no quotes required
Construction	\$1,000 - \$99,999 requires 2 written quotes
Construction	\$100,000 + must be publicly tendered

<i>Atlantic Procurement Agreement (APA) – NB, NS, NL, PEI</i>	
Public Notice Threshold	
Goods	\$10,000 + must be publicly tendered
Services	\$50,000 + must be publicly tendered
Construction	\$100,000 + must be publicly tendered

<i>Agreement on Internal Trade – Canadian Free Trade Agreement (CFTA) – All Provinces, Territories and Federal Government</i>	
Public Notice Threshold	
Goods	\$25,300 + must be publicly tendered
Services	\$101,100 + must be publicly tendered
Construction	\$101,100 + must be publicly tendered
