At the February 19, 2020 regular meeting of Council of the Rural Municipality of Belfast - Council approved Resolution # R2020-01, which saw the awarding of: ***\$231,622.08*** in Gas Tax Funding through the PEI/Canada Infrastructure Secretariat 2019/2024 Gas Tax Funding Program.
