**FLAT RIVER PIONEER CEMETERY** – Janice read the registered letter sent to the Municipality in regards to access to Flat River Pioneer Cemetery from Campbell Lea (Barristers & Solicitors) signed by April Rafuse for Geoff Gibson on behalf of Nancy and Graham Gurniak. Kip reported he did get a letter back from Allister Beaton. Roger Larrabee gave a very detailed report since 1962 what was happening in regards to the right away to the cemetery. Mike Adam also gave a very detailed report how he has everything documented from day 1 when he moved to Beaton Lane. A lengthy discussion was held among the residents and council members. Robert MacDonald suggested we hire a lawyer and get an injunction. The Minister has the power to access the property. We need to make the Government aware of this situation. Forest Beaton has attended the last two meetings. Council needs clarification on who is the Trustee for the Pioneer Cemetery. Cheryl (Beaton) Ostrowski has been trying since 2015 to get this resolved. Concern was expressed about the absence of the Trustee.

It was moved by Frieda Billard, seconded by Gary MacLeod, that we hire a lawyer to look into this matter. Motion carried.

**OTHER BUSINESS** – Janice read her letter thanking the Councilors and residents for having the opportunity to work as their Administrator for 30 years. With the new Municipal Government Act now in place and the upcoming election in November, she submitted her resignation effective August 31<sup>st</sup>.
